22 places to enjoy a picnic in the fresh air

SAINT-MARTIN'S DOOR | SAINT-ÉMILION

300 M



Grassed area with a water point.
Benches (no table), bin.



From the Tourist Office, take the “rue des Anciennes Écoles”. At the end of the street, turn right to pass the old Saint-Martin gate. The small garden is immediately on your left, down below..



You will also find two stone tables and benches in the “rue du Couvent”, at the back of the King’s Tour, with a panoramic view.

You will also find stone benches at the Brunet Gate in Saint-Émilion.



GUADET PARK | SAINT-ÉMILION

500 M



Grassy municipal park, benches (no table), bin, playground. Butcher's and delicatessen shop; small grocery store nearby (called “Utile”). Parking and toilets nearby.



Guadet Park is located in the north of the village, near the Saint-Émilion roundabout. To get there by car, take the roundabout and follow the direction Montagne (D122). The entrance to the parking lot will be within a few meters on your left (follow the sign "Gendarmerie").



BARBANNE AREA | MONTAGNE

3 KM



Grassed area with parking.
Six tables/benches, bins.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, take the D122 towards Montagne (North). The Barbanne area is on the roadside on your right, 2km away, at the entrance of the Yelloh campsite.

JEAN-LOUIS FAURE PARK | SAINT-LAURENT-DES-COMBES

4,5 KM



Tables/benches in a grassed park with trees, bin.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, follow the direction of "Saint-Émilion Sud". At the end of the road, turn left towards La Gaffelière. At the entrance of the town, turn left towards Saint-Laurent des-Combes on the D245. In the center of the village, turn right towards the town hall. After the railway, turn right again and about 500m beyond, the park will be on your left.

ROMANESQUE CHURCH | SAINT-SULPICE-DE-FALEYRENS

4,5 KM



Tables/benches in a grassed park with trees, bin.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, follow the direction of "Saint-Émilion Sud". At the end of the road, turn left towards La Gaffelière. At the entrance of the town, turn left towards Saint-Laurent des-Combes on the D245. In the center of the village, turn right towards the town hall. After the railway, turn right again and about 500m beyond, the park will be on your left.

ARVOUET AREA | MONTAGNE

6 KM



Grassed area, two tables/benches, bin.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, take the D243 towards Saint-Christophe des Bardes and continue for 2.2km. After Château Badette, leave the D243 then turn left and go along the Château Moulin de Lagnet (left side) and Laplagnotte-Bellevue (right side). After the small stone bridge going over the Barbanne, turn right on the "chemin de Tuilerie de Cazelon" and keep going for 3,8km (on Chemin Tuilerie then Arvouet). At the crossroads (chemin Arvouet and Montagne), the area will be on the opposite side, on the right.

THE WINDMILLS OF CALON | MONTAGNE

6,5 KM



Four tables, bin, shaded space in an undergrowth. Exceptional panoramic view. Possible to visit the windmills by appointment (Mr. Boidron - +33 (0)6 11 91 07 60). Botanical path.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, take the D122 towards Montagne (North). At the entrance of the village of Montagne, at the stop sign, turn left on the D244. Take the second road on your right, "Route de Bertin" then continue straight forward for 500m. The windmills of Calon will be on your left.

MENHIR OF PIERREFITTE | SAINT-SULPICE-DE-FALEYRENS

6,5 KM



One table located near the Menhir (standing stone).



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, follow the direction "Saint-Émilion Sud". At the end of the road, turn left towards La Gaffelière. Cross the village, then the railway. At the stop sign, turn right onto the D670. Follow the road for 3.2 km and at the roundabout take the 4th exit onto the D19. After 900 m, the Menhir of Pierrefitte will be on your left.



THE TOURANS CROSS | SAINT-ETIENNE-DE-LISSE

7 KM



Shady and wooded place with a beautiful view over the plain, bins.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, take the direction of "Saint-Émilion Sud". At the end of the detour, turn left to leave the village. At the entrance of La Gaffelière, turn immediately on the right towards St-Laurent-des-Combes - St-Etienne-de-Lisse (D245). After a few kilometers, go through St-Etienne-de-Lisse and pass the town hall. Then, at the exit of the village, turn immediately to the left (D130) and park on the school parking lot. Take the path running along the house and the vineyards (near the give way sign "cédez le passage"), which allows you to reach the top of the plateau. The picnic area is located at the top in the woods, 5 minutes walking from the parking lot.

THE FORMER PORT OF PIERREFITTE | SAINT-SULPICE DE FALEYRENS

7 KM



Table/bench on a grassy area facing the Dordogne river.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, follow the direction "Saint-Émilion Sud". At the end of the road, turn left towards La Gaffelière. Cross the village, then the railway. At the stop sign, turn right. Continue straight on for 4 km until the roundabout. At the roundabout, take the 4th exit on D19. After seeing the Menhir of Pierrefitte on your right, take the next right. Then turn to the left and finally, turn to the right.

THE VIGNONET PONTOON | VIGNONET

7,2 KM



Grassy area along the Dordogne river, shaded. Two tables and two benches. Parking along the grassed area, landscape reading panels.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, follow the direction of "Saint-Émilion Sud". At the end of the road, turn left towards La Gaffelière. Cross the village, then the railway. At the stop sign, turn left and take the roundabout. Take the first exit to continue on the D670 towards Saint-Jean-de-Blainac. Turn right onto D243E2. Turn slightly left, then facing the river, turn right.



PICNIC AREA OF THE OLD PRESBYTERY | NÉAC

8 KM



Two tables/benches, bin.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, take the direction Libourne (D243) for about 2.8km, then turn right when you find the sign indicating the direction of Pomerol-Néac (D245). Follow the Néac directional signs. At the entrance of the town, continue by the road that goes up, then, when you reach the top, turn left immediately in the direction of the church. The parking lot will be on your right, a few meters after the church. The picnic area is next to the cemetery and offers a view of the Barbanne river.

FONTMURÉE AREA | MONTAGNE

8 KM



Grassed area with parking.
Two tables/benches, bin.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, take the D122 in the direction of Montagne. At the entrance of the village at the stop sign, go straight forward. Follow "Route d'Ambrois" and "Route de Paradis/C205" towards "Route des Artigues/D122E5". Turn left on "Route des Artigues/D122E5". After Château Calon, turn right, "Route de Fontmurée". At the crossroads with the D121E2, go straight ahead and take the first to the right towards "Chemin du Lavoir". The area is located next to the wash house.



SAINT-GENÈS AREA | SAINT-GENÈS-DE-CASTILLON

8,8 KM



One table located near the tennis court and the church.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, follow D243E1 and D243 towards Saint-Genès-de-Castillon for 8.2 km. As you enter the village of Saint-Genès-de-Castillon, you will see the church on your left. Turn left immediately afterwards. The picnic area will be 150m further on your right.

TOURISTIC AREA | LUSSAC

9,5 KM



Four tables/benches, bins, toilets, playground, health trail.
Close to the village of Lussac.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, follow the direction of Montagne, and go to the village. At the entrance of Montagne, at the stop sign, turn right to cross the village. Turn left shortly after the church, following the direction of Lussac. When you arrive in Lussac, go straight through the village by the streets of Verdun and Gambetta, until you reach the "Place de la République", where you will find the church. Go down by the rue du 8 mai 1945 which runs along the church on the right. At the bottom of the street, turn right bypassing the cemetery. The area will be a little further on your left.

MEMORIAL OF PUISSEGUIN | PUISSEGUIN

10 KM



Grassy area.
Two tables/benches, bin and toilets.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, follow the direction of Montagne and go to the village. At the entrance of Montagne, at the stop sign, turn right to cross the village. After the church, go straight on D244 for 4km. At the crossing with the D17, on the place known as "Longues Règes", turn right on the D17, in the direction of Puisseguin-bourg. Once you arrive in Puisseguin, go straight on through the village. Pass the town hall and continue until you reach the church of St Pierre, where you can park. The memorial is below the church, on the right.

LAMPREY GARDEN | LAVAGNAC (SAINTE-TERRE)

10 KM



Six tables/benches, bins, toilets in the municipal hall.

Picnic area located in the center of Lavagnac, in the "Jardin de la Lamproie". Few local shops nearby.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, follow the direction of "Saint-Émilion Sud". At the end of the road, turn left towards La Gaffelière. Cross the village, then the railway. At the stop sign, turn left and take the roundabout. Take the first exit to continue on the D670 towards Saint-Jean-de-Blaignac. Enter Lavagnac, the Jardin de la Lamproie is in the center of the town, on your left.

MONBADON AREA | PUISSEGUIN

13 KM



Grassed area, four tables/benches, bins and a water point. Parking and toilets nearby. Area located next to the church of Monbadon with a view on the castle of Monbadon on the heights.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, take the D122 in the direction of Montagne. At the entrance of the village, turn right at the stop sign. Cross the village and continue straight on the D244 in the direction of Puisseguin for 5km. At the crossroads with the D17, turn left on the D17 and 500m after, turn slightly right on the D244 for 1km. At the intersection, turn right on the D21 towards Villefranche-de-Lonchat. The hamlet of Monbadon will be 1.5km further on your left.

PICNIC AREA | SAINT-CIBARD

15 KM



Grassed area, two tables/benches, bin.
Parking nearby.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, take the D122 in the direction of Montagne. At the entrance of the village, turn right at the stop sign. Go through the village and continue straight on the D244 in the direction of Puisseguin during 5km. At the crossroads with the D17, turn left on the D17 and 500m after, take a slight right on D244 for 1km. At the intersection, turn right on the D21 towards Villefranche-de-Lonchat for 4km, then turn left on the D21 in the direction of Saint-Cibard. The area is located next to the town hall.

PICNIC AREA | PETIT-PALAIS-ET-CORNEMPS

16,3 KM



Leisure area with a health trail.
Five tables, a bin and a water point nearby (no toilets).



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, take the D122 in the direction of Montagne. At the entrance of the village, turn right at the stop sign. Go through the village and continue straight on the D244 in the direction of Puisseguin for 4.7km. At the crossroads, turn left on the D17 direction Monbadon/St-Cibard/Francis and follow this road for 1,9km. Turn left on D17 towards Monbadon/St-Cibard/Francis/St-Médard-de-Guizières. Turn slightly to the right on the D21, follow this road for 4.7km: the leisure area will be on your left.

PICNIC AREA | FRANCIS



Grassed area, three shaded stone tables/benches.
Parking nearby.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, take the D122 towards Montagne. At the entrance of the village, turn right at the stop sign. Go through the village and continue straight on the D244 in the direction of Puisseguin during 5km. At crossroads with the D17, turn left on the D17 towards Monbadon/St-Cibard/Francis. 600m further, take the road slightly on the right on D244 then turn right on the D21. Follow the road for 5.5km, then turn left on the D119. There will be a parking lot 400m further on your left. The picnic area is at the end of the parking lot, on the left.



BONUS - OUTSIDE OF THE SAINT-ÉMILION AREA

PICNIC AREA | CABARA

12,4 KM



Grassed area on the banks of the Dordogne (partly shaded)
Three tables and bins.



At the Saint-Émilion roundabout, follow the direction of "Saint-Émilion Sud". At the end of the road, turn left towards La Gaffelière. Cross the village, then the railway. At the stop sign, turn to the left and take the roundabout. Take the first exit to continue on the D670 in the direction of Saint-Jean-de-Blaignac. Cross the bridge to get to Saint-Jean-de-Blaignac then take the direction of Branne, on the right in the curve (on the D18) and 1 km further on, turn right again in the direction of Cabara by the "Avenue du Port - D18". The picnic area will be on your right, 800m further.
