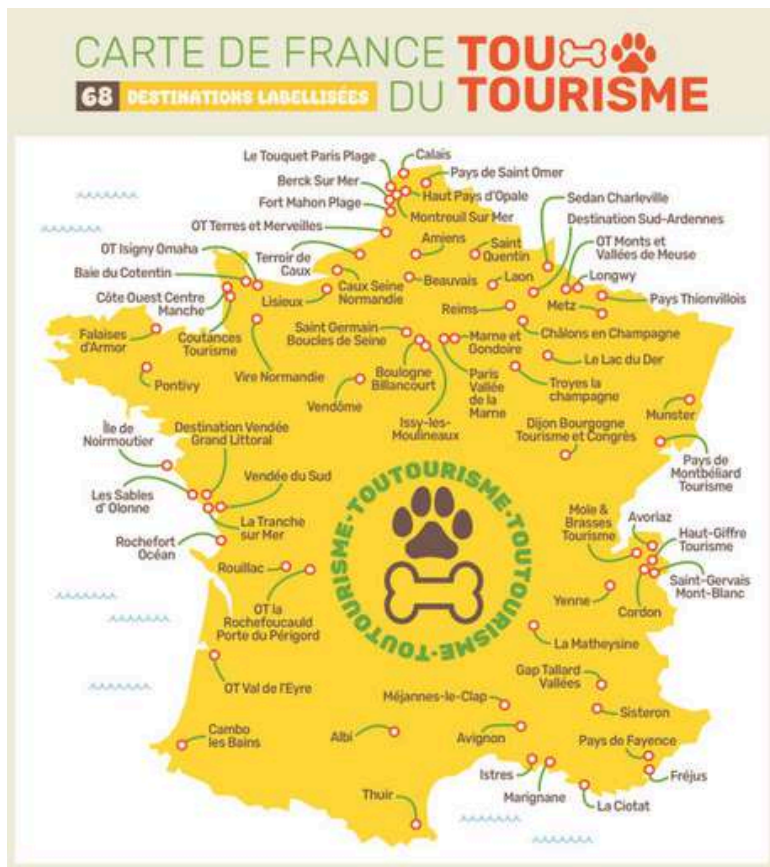

Your Tourist Information Office will therefore be able to advise you on accommodation, outings with your dog and what to do at visitor attractions, thanks to this carefully compiled brochure.

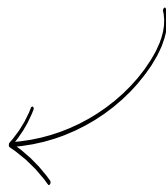

## DRINKING WATER POINTS

Feeling a bit thirsty and your water bottle's empty?

There are four freely accessible water points in the village of Saint-Émilion :

- The tap at Parc Guadet
- The toilets behind the Collegiate Church
- The toilets at Espace Villemaurine
- The toilets at Place Bouqueyre

## DOG WASTE BAG DISPENSERS

To ensure that your visit to Saint-Émilion leaves no trace, the local council has provided four dog waste bag dispensers.

They are dark grey in colour and can be recognised by their Sepra'tik logo. They are located :

- In the Guadet car park, behind the gendarmerie near the public toilets
- At the entrance to Parc Guadet, on the campervan side
- Near Chemin des Fossés (next to Espace Villemaurine)
- On Place Bouqueyre (at the bottom of the village) opposite the restaurant Le Médiéval
- At the small square between the Tour du Roy restaurant and the Pizzeria du Vieux Lavoir.
- By the steps leading to the mini park next to the Porte Saint-Martin

## **A few tips for their paws !**

### **The ground in the medieval town might take you by surprise!**

For your dog's comfort :

- **Scorching cobblestones** : In direct sunlight, the stone heats up quickly. If the ground is too hot for your hand, it's too hot for their paw pads too! Don't hesitate to carry them over exposed areas or put protective boots on them.
- **Slippery cobblestones** : Our streets are old and smooth. If it rains, it gets slippery ! Take your time on slopes, especially if your companion is a bit of a daredevil !

Oops, a last-minute oversight? On your way to your holiday destination, you realise that your dog's essentials — dry food, wet food or treats — have been left at home...
