HOW TO GET TO SAINT-ÉMILION

BY TRAIN & TAXI



Saint-Emilion is on the TER line no. 33 'Bordeaux-Bergerac-Sarlat'. Find all the timetables and live traffic conditions [here](#).

If you take the train, you can also get off at the previous station in Libourne and book a taxi to go to Saint-Emilion. A list of taxis can be sent to you on request.

Please note that there is no service available at the Saint-Emilion station

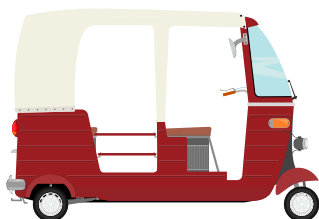


FROM THE STATION TO THE VILLAGE

The train station is located 1.5 km downhill from Saint-Emilion, so at least 20 to 30 minutes' walk away.

Please be aware that there are no pavements on some sections of the route.

During the summer season, you may enjoy a shuttle service between the station and the village :



- Tuk-Tuk des Cordeliers on +33 (0) 5 24 79 11 41 or on +33 (0) 5 57 24 42 13 for a transfer. The cost is €5 per person.

HOW TO GET TO SAINT-ÉMILION

BY BUS



from april to october, you can get to Saint-Emilion from bordeaux or Libourne by taking the regional bus of Gironde on the route no. 304. The days and times of service can be consulted [here](#).

The bus stop in Saint-Emilion is at the Place Bourgeoise roundabout.

TAILORED & ON-DEMAND TRANSPORT



tailored and on demand transport Registration is based on an application form that must be submitted to the Communauté de communes. (Lieu-dit Simard, parking de la Gare, 33330, Saint-Emilion - 05 57 55 21 60).

• PARKING



14 free parking spaces are reserved for holders of the european parking card in the village :

YOUR TOURIST OFFICE

The Tourist Office is Tourisme & Handicap certified!

In 2026, the Tourist Office was awarded the national Tourisme & Handicap label (for physical, visual, hearing, and mental disabilities). This certification reflects our commitment to providing a tailored welcome and accessible services for a peaceful stay.

The team at the Grand Saint-Emilionnais Tourist Office has been involved in an accessibility initiative for several years, and is pleased to follow regular training in accessibility in a variety of fields. Each one will do his utmost to advise you according to your needs and help you make the most of your stay.



We welcome you all year round at the Tourist Office in Saint-Emilion. In summer as in winter you will meet our team of tourist advisors on hand to answer your questions and provide you a personalized welcome for your discovery to the region.



You may also find what you're looking for in our shop.



Pets, kept on a leash, are welcome in the Tourist Office and during our guided tours.

YOUR TOURIST OFFICE

(Open all year round except on December 25 and on Mondays and Tuesdays from November to February/March.)

Located in the upper part of the village, the tourist office is accessible through the large glass doors by climbing down 4 steps

A lift will take you up to the entrance hall rather than down the steps. To do this, use the white door on the left of the main façade. Simply press 0.



OUR EQUIPMENT



Lounge seating is also available in the lobby.



Lounge seating are also available. Some reception desks have been lowered at the "information" and "ticketing" points.



We have a magnetic induction loop at the information desk.



A document presenting the village is available in Braille to be consulted at the front desk.



Suitable documentation is available on request.

staff will give you some maps showing you the accessibility of the streets.

Our maps are also available for download on our website to explore the city for a gentle stroll, in a wheelchair or even with a pushchair.

You'll also find these maps at the end of this guide.



If you visit the village in a wheelchair, we advise you to be accompanied.

To discover Saint-Emilion at your own pace, we created 3 self-guided walking tours , one of which is wheelchair accessible. They are available free of charge on request at the Tourist Office

Most of the village centre is pedestrianised. Rue Madame Bouquey, Rue des Girondins and Rue du Clocher, where the tourist office is located, are pedestrianised every day from 11am to 6pm (except weekends in low season).

GUIDED TOURS

The Tourist Office and its partners organise a variety of guided tours and excursions all year round. consult [our online shop](#) for more details and booking.

• Underground Saint-Emilion

By following a Tour guide from the tourist office, discover the most 4 emblematic monuments located in the very city center of Saint-Emilion:

- The Hermitage of Emilion (access by staircase only)
- The Trinity Chapel (ground-level access)
- Catacombs (access by few steps going down + uneven floor)
- The Monolithic Church : largest monolithic church in Europe from the middle ages (ground-level access possible)

SERVICES

RESTROOM



Restrooms at the espace Villemaurine (bus parking and excursion departure point) are free of charge and wheelchair accessible. Restrooms at the square Raymond Pointcaré (next to the collegiate church) are also wheelchair accessible but requiring 50 cents.

WHEELCHAIR RENTAL SERVICE



You have the possibility to rent a wheelchair by contacting the pharmacy of Saint-Emilion : please call it at least 24 hours in advance for a booking on 0033 (0)5 57 24 70 74 from monday to saturday.

If you let us know in advance, we can also make the wheelchair available at weekends.

ATMS / CASH MACHINES



- **Crédit Agricole**

Located on the corner of the Girondins street and Madame Bouquey street, a gentle slope leads you to 2 accessible counters. Both have keypads with Braille buttons.

- **Caisse d'Epargne**

Located on the corner of Guadet street and Mercadieu square, the outside counter has a call button and the bank is equipped with a magnetic loop. In every establishment of the Caisse d'Epargne institution, a service of sign language video-interpretation and instant speech Transcription is available.



SERVICES

TOWN HALL

 6 place Pioceau - 33330 Saint-Emilion



To enter the town hall, there are a few steps going up and another access by a gentle slope on the left side of the main entrance that leads you to the garden on the other side.

POST OFFICE

 11 Rue Guadet, 33330 Saint-Émilion

the post office : the entrance is undeveloped and located directly on the pavement of the main street.

the letterbox is located in Marcadieu Square.

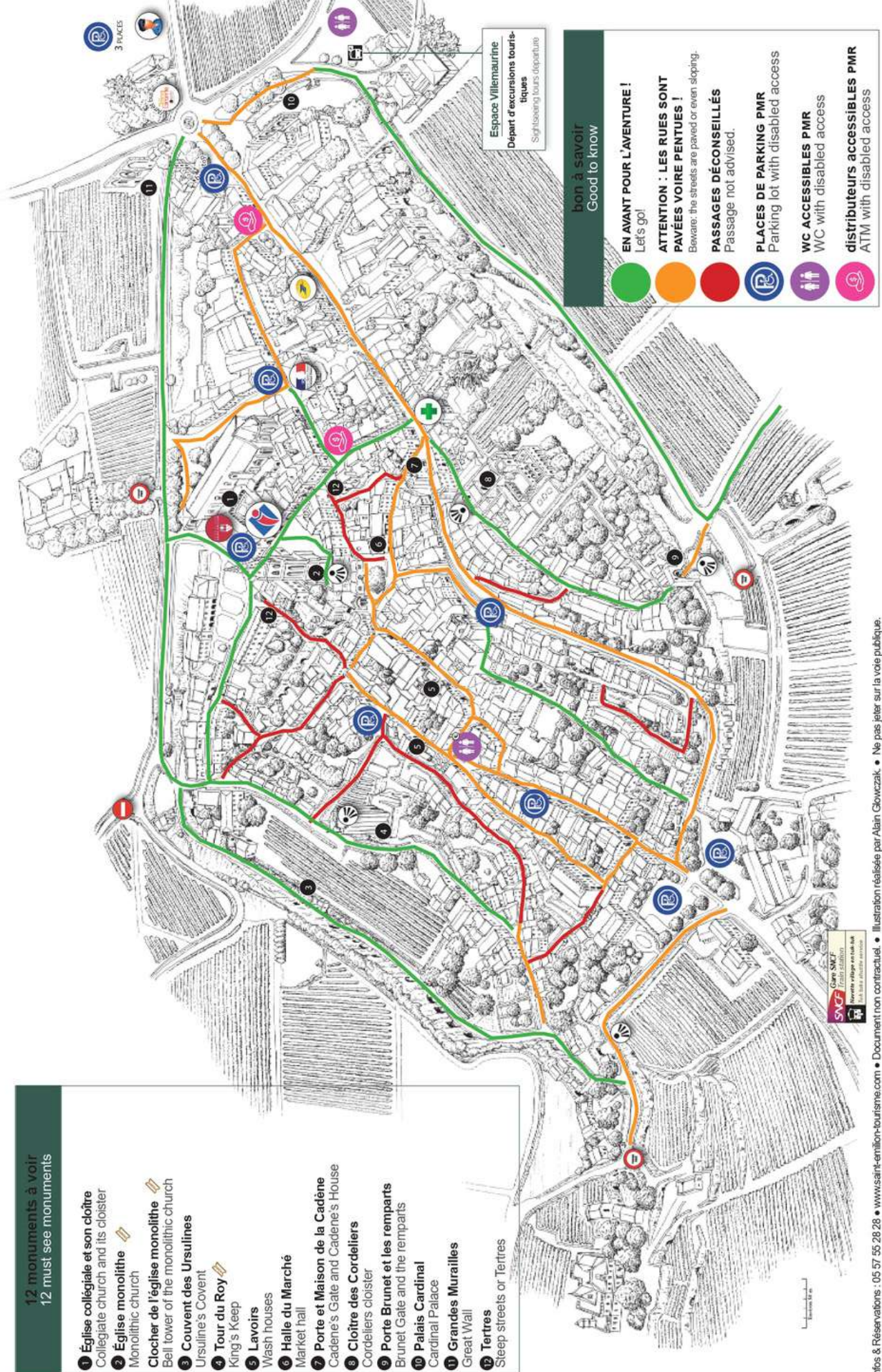

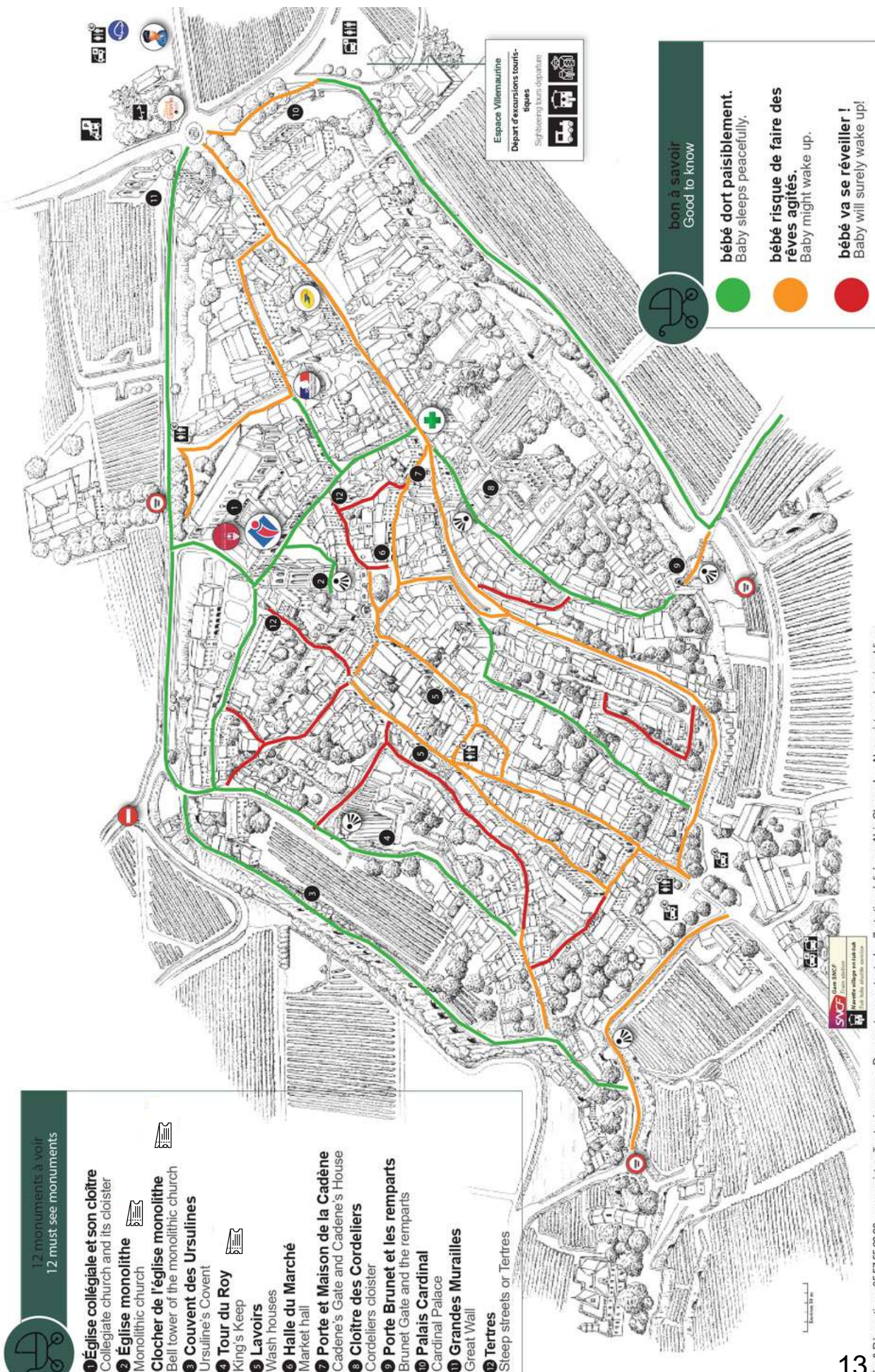
