



GOOD TO KNOW



Wear comfortable, low-heeled shoes to feel comfortable on the narrow cobblestone streets, some of which are quite steep.



As there is a significant temperature difference between the outdoor city and the wine cellars or the underground monuments (constant temperature of 13°C - 55°F), we recommend you take a light sweater with you in summer.



You will find several toilets in Saint-Emilion:

- **In the upper part of the village:**
Free: Espace Villemaurine;
Paying: behind the collegiate church, Gendarmerie (police station) parking.
- **In the lower part of the village:**
Paying: near the old wash houses and Place Bouqueyre.



There is a limited number of parking spaces, but you will be able to park your car on the free parking lot behind the Gendarmerie and paying parkings (around the collegiate church in the upper town and Place Bouqueyre in the lower part of the village). Rate: €2/hour and 5 hours max.



There are 2 parking areas for buses: the first at Espace Villemaurine (top of the town), the second free parking is outside the train station (lower part of the town, about 1.5km from the village).



Vehicles wider than 2 meters or heavier than 6 metric tons (GDT) are not allowed in the center of Saint-Emilion. Therefore, you will need to park outside the village.



UNESCO listed eight of these villages on the World Heritage List for their « cultural landscape » and the Dordogne river as a « biosphere reserve »





The 22 Grand Saint-Emilionnais AREA VILLAGES

BELVÈS-DE-CASTILLON

Marked by the end of the Hundred Years War, the village hosts every year the show « La Bataille de Castillon » at the Chateau de Castillon » at the Chateau de Castegens..



MONTAGNE

Gathering of three municipalities in 1973: Montagne, Saint-Georges and Parsac. The village owns an important number of churches (Saint-Martin, Saint-Georges and Notre-Dame-de-Parsac), chapels, chateaux and mills with the renowned « mills of Calon ».



NÉAC

Néac is notable for its vineyards, its heritage and its winegrowers' dedication to obtaining an "AOC". Today, the village's main attraction is Chateau Siaurac.



FRANCS

After the battle of Vouillé in 507, Clovis seized the Aquitaine region. A detachment of the frankish army settled in a place that took the Latin name « ad francos » which means « belonging to the Franks », becoming later « Francs ».



GARDEGAN-ET-TOURTIRAC

Gardegan-et-Tourtirac seems to have been inhabited since the prehistoric period. The Chateau de la Pierrière, the churches of Saint-Martin and Saint-Pierre, dating from the medieval period, are today the remains of a rich past.



LES ARTIGUES-DE-LUSSAC

The construction of the abbey and church of Faize in the 12th century (then destroyed during the French Revolution) marked the beginning of the development of the village. Today, the Sacré Coeur church, dating back to the 19th century, is remarkable for its interior frescoes and stained glass windows.




LUSSAC

Numerous Gallo-Roman vestiges are still visible in Lussac, such as the « Villa de Lucius » or the Gallic megalith of « le tertre de Picampeau », evidence of its long history.



PETIT-PALAIS-ET-CORNEMPS

The municipality has two churches - the 12th century classified Saint-Pierre church and the 11th century registered Notre-Dame church - that were the scene of violent battles between Protestants and Catholics at the end of the 16th century during the wars of religion.



PUISSEGUIN

Today, the village is remarkable for its two castles - Monbadon and Puisseguin - as well as for its churches Saint-Martin and Saint-Pierre, which reflect its rich medieval heritage.



SAINT-CHRISTOPHE-DES-BARDES

The 769 hectares of the village are located on the plateau of the Jurisdiction. Its Romanesque church is listed as a Historic Monument with a portal dating back to the 12th century



SAINT-CIBARD

Between lakes, woods, hills and vineyards, the village of Saint-Cibard is located on the ridge line separating the Dordogne from the Isle valley and is part of the denomination « Francs Côtes de Bordeaux ».




Saint-Emilion

A magnificent medieval town that owes its reputation to the quality of its wine and its rich heritage. The village contains many protected Historic Monuments.




SAINT-ÉTIENNE DE LISSE

This delightful little village owns a rich heritage, including a 12th century church that is listed on the Supplementary List of Historic Monuments. The medieval château de Pressac, where the English surrender may have taken place at the end of the Hundred Years War, rises at the top of the village



SAINT-GENÈS-DE-CASTILLON

Over its whole territory, the built heritage is rich of about fifty elements: fountains, laundries, dovecotes, churches... The natural heritage is also important as woods and forests represent 95 ha of the 680 ha of the village.



SAINT-HIPPOLYTE

The little winding road that dominates part of the Jurisdiction's woods and vineyards leads to the plateau de Ferrand, where you can find a chateau dating back to the 17th-18th centuries and a Romanesque style church.



SAINT-LAURENT-DES-COMBES

Its exceptional location, formed by a succession of valleys covered by woods and vines, offers a panorama over the Dordogne valley from the plateau where the church is located.



SAINT-PEY-D'ARMENS

The church dates back to the 13th century. Next, you can see a 16th century cross listed as a Historic Monument.



SAINT-PHILIPPE-D'AIGUILHE

Perched on a promontory on the right bank of the Dordogne river, the village developed since Antiquity. This is where the château d'Aiguilhe was erected in the Middle Ages. Destroyed, then reconstructed, it sheltered a Templars commandery in the 13th century.



SAINT-SULPICE-DE-FALEYRENS

Located in the plains of the Jurisdiction, next to the Dordogne river, the village is home to a 12th century Romanesque church listed on the Supplementary List of Historic Monuments, the ancient port of Saint-Emilion - called « de Pierrette », after a 5 meters-high menhir that still stands there today.



SAINTE-TERRE

Earth brought back from Palestine during the first crusade in the 11th century was spread at the top of the village and the church Sancta Terra was built on that place. Erected on the edge of the Dordogne river, the village of Sainte-Terre keeps a strong tradition of professional and amateur fishing.



TAYAC

Beautiful example of 12th century Romanesque style architecture, the church Notre-Dame de Tayac overlooks the vineyard landscape.



VIGNONET

Located on the banks of the Dordogne river, Vignonet lies on the South of the Jurisdiction and owns a beautiful church. You will also discover a beautiful view of the hillsides of the Jurisdiction and the town of Saint-Emilion.





Must-see MONUMENTS



A veritable open-air museum, the must-see monuments of the region are revealed to you!

THE MONOLITHIC CHURCH AND ITS BELL TOWER



Hidden under the bell tower, the dazzling monolithic church was entirely carved out from one single stone at the beginning of the 12th century.

Built between the 12th and 15th centuries and strengthened two centuries later, the bell tower is Saint-Emilion's highest point and overlooks the city. Climbing its 196 steps may be a challenge but the outstanding view from the top is definitely worth it.



THE COLLEGIATE CHURCH AND ITS CLOISTER



Built between the 12th and 15th centuries, the Collegiate church is one of the most imposing churches in Gironde. It hosted Augustine canons until the French Revolution.

CADENE'S HOUSE AND GATE



Now the last timber framed house remaining in Saint-Emilion, this beautiful building has a sculpted facade dating back to the 16th century and its foundations are much older. This was an inner gate to the city.

THE KING'S KEEP



This massive square tower from the 13th century, with 118 steps, still remains full of mystery. Today, climbing the King's Keep is one of the best ways to overlook the village and the vineyard.

THE CORDELIERS' CLOISTER



Franciscan friars settled down in Saint-Emilion in the 13th century and founded their second convent inside the city walls during the 14th century. These magnificent ruins are a haven of peace and relaxation, where you can enjoy a glass of « Crémant de Bordeaux ».

THE URSULINES' CONVENT




Founded in the 17th century by Ursuline sisters, also creators of the Saint-Emilion macaroon recipe, the convent still stands today, although only a small part remains..

THE GREAT WALL



This wall, known as the Great Wall since the 19th century, is a remnant of an impressive Dominican convent built in the 13th century outside the city walls.

BRUNET GATE



Built in the 12th and 13th centuries, it is the best preserved of the six medieval gates in the old fortification wall.

THE WASH HOUSES



These public basins, built in the 19th century, are supplied by the spring that Émilion is said to have made appear miraculously in his cave in the 8th century.

THE MARKET HALL



The ancient covered market, opening onto the former market square, was mainly used for grain storage and trade.

STEEP STREETS OR « TERTRES »



The irregular cobblestones of these scenic streets bring even more authenticity and charm to Saint-Emilion!

CARDINAL PALACE



These remains of a magnificent dwelling from the late 12th century were part of the former city walls.

THE CALON WINDMILLS



Five tower mills built in the 16th century on the Calon hillside, the highest point in the Saint-Emilion area. Two of them have been restored by their owner. Visits by appointment.

THE PIERREFITTE MENHIR




Erected nearly 4,500 years ago, the Pierrefitte menhir is the most striking prehistoric monument in the Saint-Emilion area.

A Unesco world HERITAGE SITE

Saint-Emilion's Jurisdiction is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1999 for its « cultural landscape ». A world first for a vineyard! According to the UNESCO, « the Jurisdiction of Saint-Emilion is an outstanding example of a historic vineyard landscape that has survived intact and in activity to the present day ». It also « exceptionally illustrates intensive cultivation of the vine in a region defined with precision ».

A UNESCO SITE SHAPED BY ITS HISTORY

The registration highlights an exceptional human adventure of 800 years, which includes the medieval village of Saint-Emilion and the seven villages that surround it. Without destroying it, human communities made the most of the characteristics of the territory to develop their activities and their way of life. The culture of lands, the exploitation of quarries, the urban development, the construction of religious buildings and houses: all this created a landscape in perfect harmony with the topography and the site resources.

13 centuries OF HISTORY AND TRADITIONS

The landscapes, culture and art of living of the Grand Saint-Emilion Area have been shaped by the history and traditions of this territory. Hermit Emilion's settling in the heart of an old forest, followed by five religious orders, has left marks on the area's architectural heritage as can be seen with the monasteries, convents and churches. These coexist with more than 10 000 hectares of vines that cover our territory and over 200km of underground galleries.



AT THE BEGINNING: A RELIGIOUS SITE

In the 8th century, a Breton named Émilion decided to leave Vannes, his native land, to devote himself to prayer. His wanderings would have taken him to an abbey where he became a monk and then to Ascumbas, the ancient name of our territory. Living in a cave, he would have been joined by some Benedictine disciples, founded the first religious community and evangelized the population.

After Émilion's death - around 767 - a village was built in his honor. Between the 8th and 18th centuries, five religious orders coexisted or succeeded each other at the heart of the medieval town, turning it into a high monastic place. Benedictine, Augustinian, Franciscan, Dominican monks and Ursuline sisters welcomed for several centuries the pilgrims on their way to Santiago de Compostela.

WORLD FAME: WINE

Viticulture has always been present on the right bank of Bordeaux, with the first vines dating from the 2nd century and planted by the Romans. After the collapse of the Roman Empire in the 5th century, viticulture survived and spread due to Christianity, which made wine a central element of worship ; the religious community started to grow vines. But it was in the Middle Ages, when Aquitaine was attached to the Kingdom of England, that the Saint-Émilion wines obtained their letters of nobility. However, it is only from the 19th century that a monoculture of vines was established in the Jurisdiction of Saint-Émilion. In 1884, the importance of wine on our territory was notably reflected in the creation of the first French Wine Producers Union in Saint-Émilion, now known as the Wine Council.




THE GOLDEN AGE: THE LIMESTONE EXTRACTION

Between the 9th and the 19th centuries, the stone was massively extracted from the limestone plateau creating an immense network of 80 ha of underground quarries forming a labyrinth of almost 200 km. This limestone rock was exploited relentlessly by the quarrymen of Saint-Émilion and was used for the construction of the medieval city and some Bordeaux monuments such as the Grand Théâtre. It is thanks to the transport on the Dordogne river with the gabares (traditional barges) and « coureux », (small robust ships with flat bases), that stones and food were transported towards the port of Bordeaux and the Atlantic coast since the Middle Ages. The Dordogne river was, several hundred years ago, a key factor to the economic development of the area.

Nature & GETAWAY

The Saint-Emilion area is full of treasures: endless vineyards, stunning château architecture, Romanesque and Gothic churches that have stood the test of time, mills and wash houses, rivers and ponds... Take the time to discover these treasures that are a stone throw away!

A CULTURAL LANDSCAPE

A cultural landscape is, for the UNESCO, a representative landscape of a region of the world expressing the « combined works of human beings and nature. They express a long and profound relationship between people and their environment ». In the Jurisdiction of Saint-Emilion, everything reminds us that Men and Nature moved forward together, developing the vine growing techniques that appeared more than 2000 years ago. Religious and winemaking architectures, as well as underground heritage sites, are all illustrations of a society and its skills that have to be kept alive and passed on to future generations.

THE 8 TOWNS OF THE JURISDICTION

The UNESCO registration of our territory covers the Saint-Emilion Jurisdiction area, in other words the medieval village of Saint-Emilion, the seven villages surrounding it, as well as their vineyards. From 1199 - when the Jurade was established - to 1999, this territory has been defining itself as "a family-based and united winegrowing community." This definition is one of the foundations of the UNESCO registration. A recognition in which its inhabitants take great pride: throughout these years, they all have - in their own way - contributed to the success and durability of Saint-Emilion' vineyard.

THE DORDOGNE RIVER, NATURAL BIOSPHERE RESERVE

On July 11th 2012, the International Coordinating Council of UNESCO's «Man and Biosphere» program integrated the Dordogne basin into the world network of Biosphere Reserves. The recognition offered by this program highlights the exceptional territory of the Dordogne River including a protected nature, combined with its cultural heritage and lifestyle.

Explanation OF THE WORLD HERITAGE LISTING



COMBS

The landform played a significant role in the choice of human interventions. Here, man has been able to adapt to his natural environment and exploit it to the fullest, without making any major changes, thus giving the landscape its exceptional character. The graphics of the vines highlight the slopes, the convexity or the concavity of some areas.



TRANSMISSION OF AN AGRICULTURAL SYSTEM

The main characteristic of this region is that it has preserved the agrarian structures from the late Middle Ages, which do not exceed a few hectares. No manufacture nor workshop have been set up there.



WALLS

The perfect balance between the work of Man and Nature appears in every detail, like in this major and original feature of the site: the stone walls. Those walls separating the vines from the road, built in the 18th century with the stones from the quarries, are a fencing system specific to this region to protect the vineyards from pillages.



VINE MONOCULTURE

This monoculture has created a structured, ordered and harmonious landscape, characterized by a regular rhythm.

TESTIMONY OF LIFE

A very ancient place of settlement, the natural caves inside the limestone hills, as well as the exceptional climate, fostered the settlement of humankind since prehistoric times.



WOOD

The stand of trees at the edge of the plateau above the limestone cornice, creates a colourful line, visible at a distance, that highlights the close and harmonious relationships between vegetation, terrain, geology and human activities.



BALANCE BETWEEN MAN AND NATURE

In addition to well-maintained châteaux, mansions and preserved Romanesque style churches, the Jurisdiction hosts mills and stone crosses whose conservation testifies the will of the local people to protect the site.

THE MACAROONS OF SAINT-EMILION

A remaining gourmet tradition. This speciality has been transmitted down from generation to generation in Saint-Emilion since the Ursuline sisters established their convent in the medieval city in 1620. Less colorful than the Parisian macaroons, our macaroons are only made of sweet and bitter almonds, egg whites and sugar! You can enjoy them with coffee, champagne, wine, as a dessert with fresh fruits and/or ice cream.

BUBBLES IN SAINT-EMILION

At the heart of the village, the production of Crémant de Bordeaux (sparkling white or rosé wine made according to the traditional method) has been perpetuated since the 19th century both under the King's Keep and in the darkness of the underground quarries of the old Franciscan monastery but also at the Lateyron cellars. Take a moment to follow a guided tour of these three places to discover the secrets of making and tasting their crémant.

Wine AND TERROIR

The exceptional quality of the Saint-Emilion vineyard can be explained by its remarkable geology combined with a microclimate, perfectly adapted to the wine culture. The Romans were the first ones to invest on the local soil in the 2nd century and to plant the first vines. There is no doubt that wine already occupied an important place in the Gallo-Roman period, although the monoculture of vines in the Jurisdiction of Saint-Emilion was implemented from the 19th century.



THE AREA

To make world-famous wines, you need an exceptional terroir! This one is a subtle alliance between:

4 TYPES OF SOILS: limestone, clay, gravel and sand.

3 MAIN GRAPE VARIETIES: Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon.

A TEMPERATE OCEANIC CLIMATE ideal for wine growing, with moderate temperature variations between summer and winter and a well distributed rainfall throughout the year.

THE UNIQUE KNOW-HOW OF WINE GROWERS in our area.

THE CLASSIFICATION OF SAINT-EMILION WINES

To obtain the Grand Cru designation, winemakers must be located on a strictly defined territory, sternly respect established specifications and of course, produce red wine.

The wines of the Saint-Emilion Grand Cru designation can aspire to a classification, reviewed every 10 years (the last one dating back to 2022) and distinguishing 3 levels of quality:

1ST GRAND CRU CLASSÉ A - 2 WINE ESTATES:
Château Figeac - Château Pavie

1ST GRAND CRU CLASSÉ - 12 WINE ESTATES

GRAND CRU CLASSÉ - 71 WINE ESTATES

It is the Wine Council, through the Jurade, which ensures the reputation and promotion of these wines, both in France and abroad.

THE *Furade*

While the Aquitaine region was under English supremacy since 1152, the charter signed by King John in 1199 gave political, economical and judicial power to Saint-Emilion and then to its jurisdiction.

Dissolved during the French Revolution, the Jurade was reconstituted in 1948 by local winemakers in its current form as a brotherhood. Nowadays, the Jurade is a witness to the traditions of the past and guarantees the values of respect for heritage, conviviality and solidarity. As a link

between past and future, this prestigious brotherhood organizes receptions and induction ceremonies during which the 130 Jurats (members of the Jurade) perpetuate the values of sharing and the transmission of legacy and tradition while embracing modernity. Its members wear their traditional red robes twice a year: for the Spring Festival in June and for the Ban des Vendanges in September (harvest celebration).

The red wines

As you enter the park and walk a few steps, the imposing Montaigne Tower comes into view. Dating from the 14th and 16th centuries, it is where Montaigne wrote his famous 'Essais'. The 19th-century, 'Belle Époque'-style château is more than a place of remembrance, as it is also a winegrowing estate. After the guided tour, stay for a tasting of the estate's wines, made the traditional way.

Events are organised at the estate throughout the year, including an Easter egg hunt, white-themed evenings in the summer and literary talks entitled 'Montaigne à livre ouvert' (Montaigne, an open book)!
